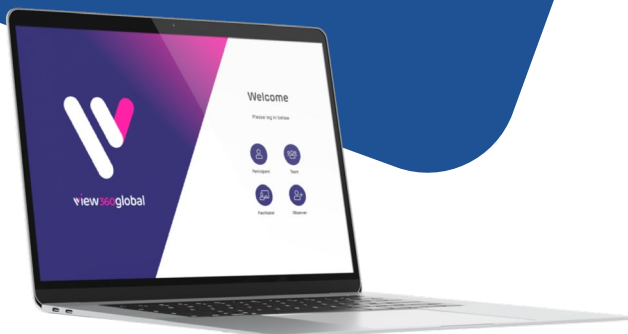

Course Programme

■ Module 1

The first day addresses pre travel planning required for travelling in this modern world where we are now required to take a more considered and cautious approach to reduce personal risk.

Topics covered will include:

Country background

Political risks, laws, transport, culture and customs

Health

Vaccinations, health threats, diseases, pandemic updates, in country medical care, obtaining emergency treatment and on entry declarations

Travel documentation

Passport & visa protocols, insurances, driving licences, travel tickets, letters of introduction

Equipment

IT communications and backup devices / plans, personal security items and medical kits

Travel planning

Where are you going, who are you meeting and how are you being transported

■ Module 2

The second day addresses the importance of safe travel in country and how to reduce personal risk whether choosing accommodation, using local transport or crisis response. We will then run an immersive learning exercise using our View360Global platform in which the participants will use the knowledge gained on the course to plan a trip and then mitigate a series of real-life events that unfold during the course of the period of travel.

Topics covered will include the consideration of:

Profile management

Conduct in public places including airports, exhibiting affluence, cultural observations, carrying valuables, avoiding public demonstrations or disorder

Accommodation

Personal security, location of room, escape routes, in room security

Transport

Using taxis, public transport threats and obtaining advice or information

Kidnap threats

Planning routes and times, situational awareness, transportation, response actions

Crisis response

Embassies and Consulates, alternate refuge, evacuation plans
